St. John Vianney Academy will be offering a few classes for high school students in the 2021-2022 school year. Students need not be enrolled in SJVA to participate. They can take one of the courses or all! We are offering the following classes, as long as we reach our minimum enrollment goal of at least 5 students per class. Classes will involve reading and work done at home and a one-hour (or 1.25 hour, class dependent) in-person class per week with instruction and discussion; teachers will grade students' assignments. All classes will take place on Thursdays (morning or afternoon, times TBD) on the SJVA campus.
